However, after a review of all the issues, the parties agree that they do not want to go to trial and instead agree to the following stipulation in settlement of the issues in this matter:

Pursuant to Agriculture and Markets Law Section 123 it is hereby stipulated that the dog known as Buster Brown owned by Anthony Rooney is deemed a dangerous dog. The following conditions are agreed upon:

- 1- Mr. Rooney, owner of Buster Brown must maintain a 6 foot fence at 196 S Brookside Avenue, Freeport ny.
- 2- Said fence must have a self latching gate, and "beware of dog" sign must be posted
- 3- Buster Brown must wear a mussel when being walked ~~and in yard~~ and when not confined in yard and leashed.
- 4- Must comply with all Nassau County Laws including "Bennys Law"
- 5- All conditions must be complied within

6 - Buster Brown will not be returned until an inspection is complete by the Town of Hempstead Animal Control Shelter.


7 - Buster Brown shall be spayed or neutered, licensed and vaccinated, and microchipped.
